## MOST VICTIMS KNOW THEIR ATTACKER



A child is much more likely to be sexually abused by a recognized, trusted adult than by a stranger.

34% of assailants were family members

58% were acquaintances

of the perpetrators were strangers to the victim









### PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IS CRUCIAL

### THINGS A PARENT CAN DO:

- · Help kids understand what sexual abuse is
- Empower them to avoid abuse
- · Teach kids to tell someone immediately



#### Involvement by parents is crucial because

65% of social workers

53% of doctors and

58% of physician assistants

do not report all suspected cases of child maltreatment.
